

NOTES FROM THORNHAM

THORNHAM 200 YEARS AGO

This attractive engraving from a book published in 1819 shows the view up to Thornham Magna Church and the Hall from the ford (now a bridge) near our red phone box. The view has become hidden by high hedges and an avenue of



great lime trees running from here to the Hall. On the right a stile leads to the footpath behind the hedge to the Village Hall. There is still an unusually wide roadside verge on the left. The engraver has included Thornham villagers: a mother and child play by the stream and a horseman is leading a second horse near to a small child with a dog.
