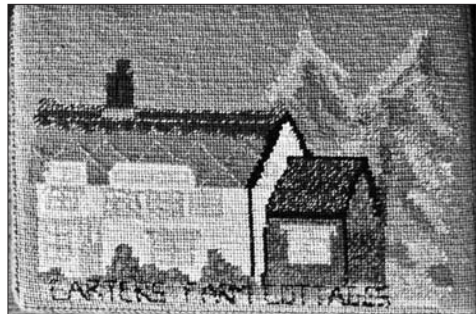
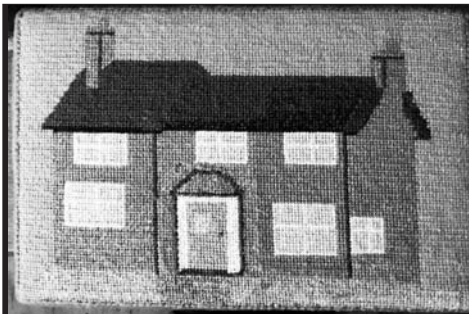
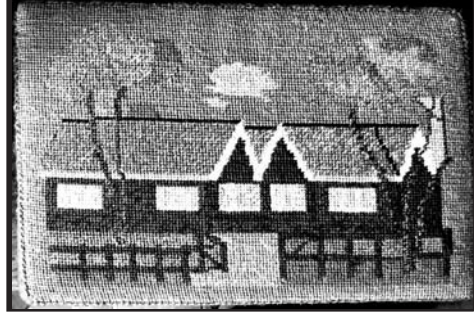
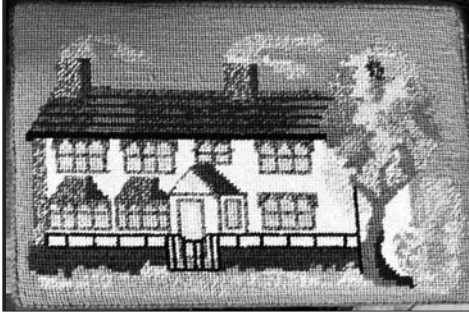


## NOTES FROM THORNHAM

Between 1990 and 1996 there was much activity in and around Thornham Parva as more than 20 men and women worked together to produce a set of 50 kneelers for the church, portraying religious symbols, and the village's natural history and buildings. Can you name those shown here?



The project was led by Ann Dentith, the designer was Alan King, and prominent among the makers were Mrs E V Coe, Mrs Simone Dale, Mrs Nora Hunt, Mr Alan and Mrs Nora King, Mrs Eva Lummis and Mrs Christine Sturgeon.

It is well worth visiting the church to look at the whole set, as well as the famous altarpiece and wall paintings. On a table near the door a ring binder with photos of the kneelers and captions in the beautiful handwriting of Kate Milford-Cottam, reveals the subject and maker of each kneeler.
